To assure the all safety measures are provided for all workers on this project, each trade contractor will complete a JHA for the project and each critical job on the project. This process will allow everyone on the project to prepare and plan ahead for safety throughout the duration of the project.

The following instructions and template have been provided to facilitate this process. If you have any questions, please do not hesitate to contact the Dimeo Construction Company (DCC) Site Safety Manager (SSM) assigned to your project. The project JHA must be received by DCC no later than 5 days prior to the commencement of work activity.
